Guardian Whiskers helps govern the overall execution of the organization's mission. The Board helps manage the organization's finances and sets long-term priorities for the programs, including the development of the Book Buddies Reading Program and the Taradiddle Youth Writing Contests. Additionally, the Board works together with the Executive Director, who is responsible for the organization's day-to-day management. Overall, the members of the Board contribute the educational, management, legal, and financial skills needed to ensure long-term organizational stability and ensure year-to-year educational excellence for Guardian Whisker's mission.

The Board of Directors has up to 5 voting members. Terms are for 2 years.

Board Member responsibilities include attendance at regular board meetings (twice per year), as well as teleconference meetings and active electronic conversations as part of Board committees. Board members also hold fiduciary responsibility for the management of organizational capital and ensuring appropriate filings with federal, state, and local authorities consistent with the organization's status as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. The attendance policy allows for removal if three consecutive meetings are missed without notice.
